

MORE IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Early bird bookings close at midnight on Sunday, 12th December 2021.
- From Monday, 13th December, the price of all bookings will increase by \$5 per child per day.
- Cancellations will not be accepted after Monday, 13th December 2021.
- o Bookings must be made via the portal.
- Bookings will cut off at midday the day before the session. Any bookings required after the cut off must be submitted via email to info@concordoshc.com.au
- Late bookings will only be accepted where vacancies permit and staff: child ratios are not affected.
- Children MUST bring a packed morning tea & lunch each day unless otherwise stated in the program.
- Parents/Carers MUST make staff aware of any special dietary requirements prior to the day of attendance so alternate arrangements can be considered (where necessary)
- COOSH is open from 7am 6pm and will provide breakfast as well as a fresh fruit daily.
- Late pickup / early drop off fees will apply for children collected after 6pm or dropped prior to 7am.
- A Non-notification fee of \$5 will apply if you fail to notify the Centre of your child's absence for a booked session. It is important that you notify the Centre of any change of plans. If the Centre has to contact you because your child has not arrived for a session, a Non-Notification fee will be charged to your OSHC account.

Each Day, your child/ren will need:

- Morning tea
- A healthy and nutritious lunch (unless otherwise specified in the program).
 - **NB: COOSH has a NUT FREE Policy**.
 - o Please ensure your child's food does not include nuts.
- A water bottle, staff will refill water bottles for children from at the water station.
 - Children will be unable to use to the water station and it is also recommended that children do not user the bubblers.
- A hat for sun safe play
- Appropriate clothing and footwear for any art / craft activities, sport, or excursions
- An appropriate backpack to hold all their belongings.



Summer Vacation Care Program December 2021 & January 2022

If you or your child are feeling unwell or experiencing flu-like symptoms – for the wellbeing of our team and all the children in our care, please do not attend our service.

- WHAT IS Concord OSHC DOING TO KEEP CHILDREN SAFE? -

Concord OSHC is committed to ensuring the health and safety for all children, families, and Educators at our service. We are actively monitoring and following all guidance provided by the NSW Department of Education and NSW Health regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19).

The most relevant advice remains that practicing good personal hygiene and cleaning is the best defence against the spread of infections.

The health and wellbeing of the children in our care and our team is always our top priority. So, to ensure that everyone is safe at Concord OSHC, we have and will continue to ensure:

- ALL Concord OSHC staff and / or visitors that come onto site have had the required doses of Covid-19
 Vaccines and provided certificates, in accordance with the Public Health Order,
- Social distancing, checking in and proper hygiene rules are followed with regard to Excursions for the December 2021 and January 2022 holidays. At this time, excursions are permitted to take place however, this is subject to change.
- All incursions from outside providers follow the strict guidelines of sanitization and cleaning.
 Cancellations will be made if needed.
- We implement social distancing techniques such as: increasing outside play and optimising our room set up
- Reinforce the importance of excellent hygiene such as washing hands, covering coughs or sneezes with a tissue or an elbow
- · Remain strict and vigilant with our cleaning routines and,
- Closely monitor all advice on stopping the spread of COVID-19
- Strictly enforcing our Infectious and Illness Disease Policy and Procedure, if you or your child is feeling unwell or experiencing flu-like symptoms – for the wellbeing of our team and all the children in our care please do not attend our service

We have also developed a specific COVID-19 risk minimisation plan for our services to keep children, families, and our team members safe. COVID-19 Information risk assessments and Policy is available in-Centre upon request.

- On days of excursions/incursions, all children booked into the Centre for the day MUST be at the Centre by the time stated on the program to allow time for appropriate instructions for be given to ensure the safety and well-being of all staff and children.
- We will always endeavour to be back by 3:30pm, unless otherwise stated in the program.
- Please do not provide your child with money for excursions as this becomes unfair to other children. We will not be making trips to the shops, nor have facilities to reheat lunches whilst on excursions.
- Please ensure your child's food is adequate in quantity and does not require any preparation.
- Travel will vary and will be specified on the permission slip.
- Parents must complete the permission slip at the time of booking for their child to attend an
 excursion. If a permission slip is not completed, the parent will be called to collect their child as they
 will not be able to attend the excursion.

- Excursion numbers will be limited based on staff numbers and the type of excursion. A full risk assessment will be completed for each excursion prior to attendance. These risk assessments are available at the Centre on request.
- Any medication must be provided to the staff with the appropriate permission slips for administration of medication. Children who are unwell will not be accepted at the service. We reserve the right to send children home in the case of contagious illness, including head lice.
- Bookings will be taken on a first come, first served basis using our ONLINE booking system. * Children must be fully enrolled at the service & have paid their term fees in full, prior to having vacation care bookings confirmed.
- Fees for vacation care are non-refundable, irrespective of attendance.
- If you have not fully enrolled at the service, please visit our portal, and complete an ONLINE enrolment system.
