Method of transport, including entering and exiting	Entering: Walk outside OOSH to front of school on Burwood Road. Catch the coach bus to the ultimate family centre and depart outside the venue. Children will follow educators into the venue. Departing: Children line up in the foyer of the play centre until the bus arrives. Children will follow educators lead on to the bus. Children will disembark the bus on Burwood Road bus stop next to the School Gates and follow educators back into COOSH. Accounting for all children: All children will be accounted for when embarking and disembarking the vehicle through headcount. When embarking and disembarking the bus, one educator will stand by the bus door and count each child individually. When onboard the bus and after entering the venue, the educators will do a final headcount before leaving the vicinity of the bus/venue. A digital roll on the centre phone will be used to ensure that all children are accounted for.

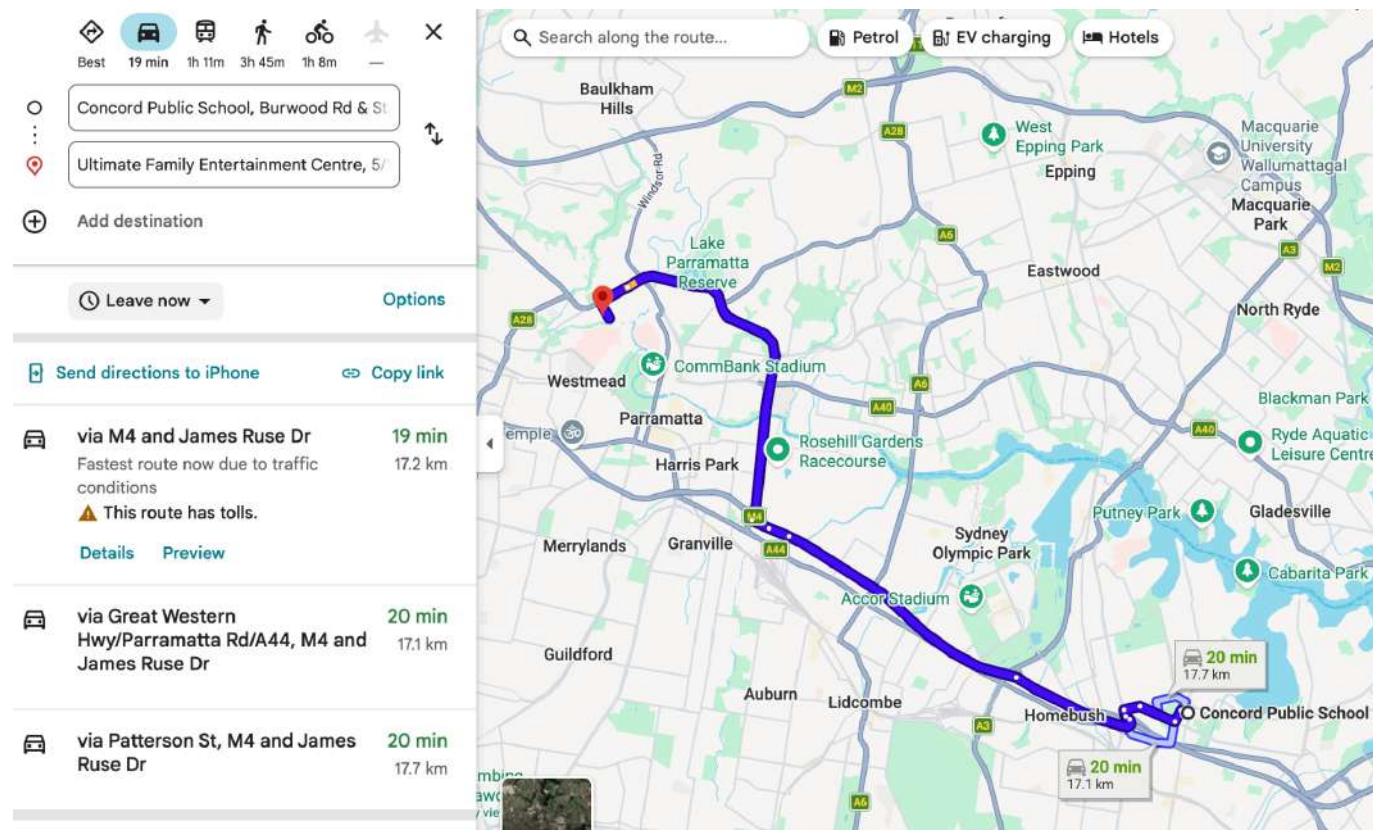

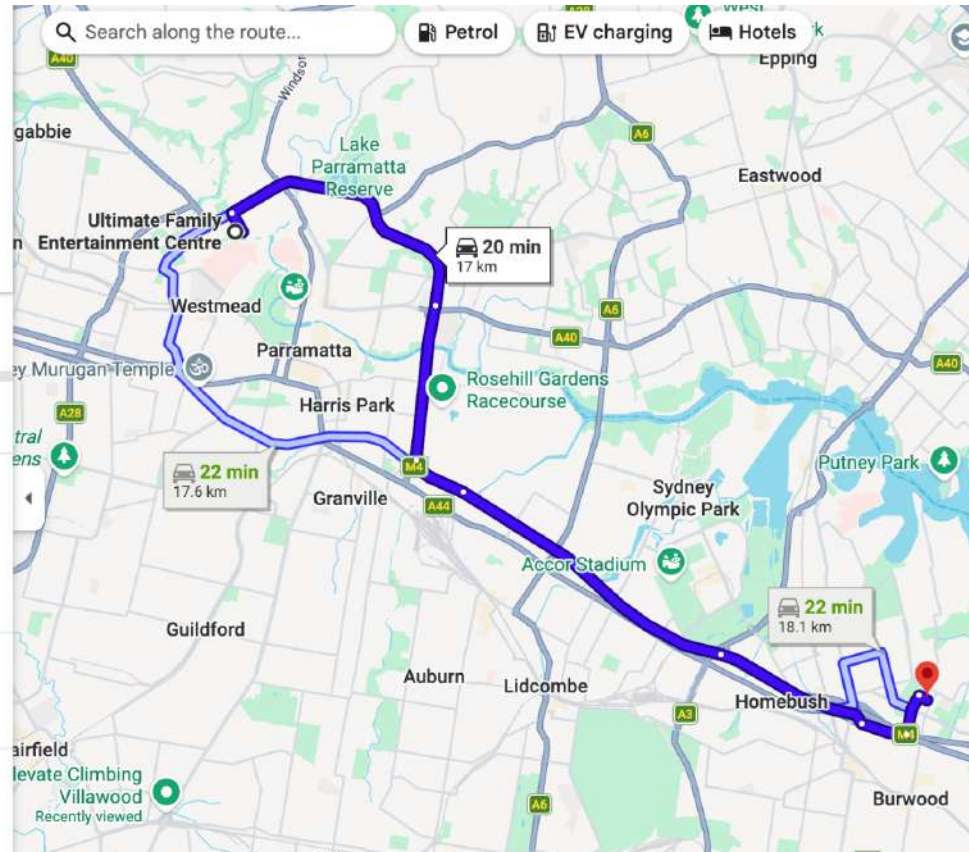
